Dear Families,

Today completes our first full week of school. Everyone is adjusting well to their new classrooms, new teachers and new procedures. We have had two school liturgies and our first all school rosary. The school day ends at 3:15 each day. It is important that someone be here to pick up your child. Any child not picked up in a timely manner will be sent to after school care. TIP OF THE WEEK

Each week the students will hear a "Tip of the Week" with the morning announcements. This is a tip that the students can practice at school and at home. The "Tip of the Week" will be in the newsletter. We ask parents to help students learn the "Tip" by practicing at home.

This week's "Tip" was: When responding to an adult, your

child must answer by saying "Yes" or "No". It is not acceptable to just nod one's head or say "Yea". Teach your child the value of eye contact. When someone is speaking, your child should keep his eyes on the person at all times. If someone else makes a comment, your child should turn and face that person.

Next week's "Tip" is: If

someone in the class wins a game or does something well, you should congratulate that person. If your teacher allows clapping it should last no longer 3 seconds, with the palms of both your hands meeting in a manner that will give the appropriate volume.
