EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLAN

Resurrection's Emergency Response Plan (ERP) is a guideline to be used in case of an emergency or a disaster. The ultimate goal is to keep the occupants of Resurrection School safe during such events.

Being prepared and understanding how to activate the ERP can reduce fear, anxiety and losses that may accompany disasters or emergencies. One way of preparing is by taking time to practice each of the different types of drills that exist in our plan.

Fire drills are held

monthly as a way to practice exiting the building in a timely manner. We also provide the opportunity to practice exiting the classrooms and going to a safe location for a tornado drill.

Additionally we will be practicing other responses to emergencies. Students had the opportunity to practice a "Code Red" on Wednesday. This is when all classrooms are locked and students are in a safe location within their classroom.

In the future we will practice a "Code Yellow." This is used in the event that it is

safer to be inside the building. In the event it is safer to be outside the building we will activate a "Code Green." If the event is such that the students would have to leave the school grounds we would walk to Bishop Ward and remain there until the all clear is given.

The ERP allows anyone to activate it and also allows for periodic practice and review for effectiveness.
