## FROM THE NURSE

Last week everyone received a letter from KSDE about best practices for stopping the spreading of germs that may cause the flu. Just for a reminder:

\*\*Keep children who are sick at home. Ill children need to stay home until they are fever free (without medication) for 24 hours.

\*\*Plan for the possibility that you will be called to bring your child home from school if they become ill.

\*\*Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when coughing or sneezing.

\*\*Wash your hands often with soap and water.

\*\*Avoid touching eyes, nose or mouth.

\*\*Practice good health habits. Get plenty of sleep, exercise, healthy food and plenty of fluids.

\*\*Get your child vaccinated for seasonal flu.

\*\*Watch for health information coming home from school
